"160,000 Kilometers of Railway Network—The Flowing Vitality of China": Economic Daily

On the first day of the National Day holiday this year, a record of 21.448 million passengers being sent by rail sets a new historical high for single-day passenger traffic. This achievement comes just five months after the previous record of 20.693 million passengers on May 1.

This new record in passenger numbers coincides with the recent milestone of China's railway network surpassing 160,000 kilometers just before the National Day holiday. Currently, China ranks first in the world for annual passenger volume, turnover and freight volume. The operating length of high speed rail has exceeded 46,000 kilometers, surpassing the total length of high speed rail in all other countries combined. This extensive railway network supports a vibrant and mobile China.

The breakthrough of 160,000 kilometers in operating railway mileage has created favorable conditions for convenient travel for the public. With this mileage, the maximum daily operational capacity for passenger trains across the country exceeds 12,000, a 184% increase compared to 2012. Among these, the number of high speed trains exceeds 10,000, marking a remarkable 426% growth since 2012.



1. WeChat (微信)

Let's start with the big one. If you ask anyone in China what is the most important app they will say WeChat. WeChat is the Swiss Army knife of apps in China. It's not just for messaging – you can use it for everything from making payments to booking taxis and hotels, and even translating languages.

Why you need it:

- Communication: Stay connected with friends and locals.
- **Payments:** Many places in China prefer WeChat Pay over cash. It now accepts International cards so you can use your phone to pay.
- **Social:** Follow official accounts for tips and events.

If you are planning on staying in China for a little while then I would urge you to get WeChat as it will make your life a lot easier if you are socialising and contacting a lot of locals whilst you are in the country.

You should set it up before you get to China but the downside is it isn't super easy for foreigners to do this. To verify your account you need to find someone who can help you register.

2. Alipay (支付宝)

Another giant in the Chinese payment landscape, Alipay is essential for making cashless payments at stores, restaurants, and online. It is very similar to WeChat but WeChat has a more social feel because you use it as a messaging service like WhatsApp but Alipay doesn't have this.

Why you need it:


- Wide Acceptance: From street vendors to luxury malls, everyone uses it.
- Ease of Use: Get the English version of the app and link your international card.
- Mini-Programs: Access services like bike rentals, translation, and more.

I've noticed that when I travel around China I use Alipay more than any other app as it has nearly everything I need in one place.









II. Electricity Generation


The power generation of industrial enterprises above the designated size experienced steady growth. In October, 731.0 billion kilowatt-hours of electricity were generated by industrial enterprises above the designated size, up by 2.1 percent year on year; with an average daily electricity generation capacity of 23.58 billion kilowatt-hours. From January to October, 7.8027 trillion kilowatt-hours of electricity were generated by industrial enterprises above the designated size, up by 5.2 percent year on year.

From the perspective of energy sources, October saw a slowdown in the growth rates of thermal, nuclear, and solar power generation by industrial enterprises above the designated size. Meanwhile, the decline in hydropower generation widened, while the growth rate of wind power generation accelerated. Among them, the thermal power generated by industrial enterprises above the designated size increased by 1.8 percent year on year, with a growth rate of 7.1 percentage points slower than that in September; the hydropower generated by industrial enterprises above the designated size decreased by 14.9 percent, with a decline expanding by 0.3 percentage point compared to September; the nuclear-power generated by industrial enterprises above the designated size increased by 2.2 percent, with a growth rate of 0.6 percentage point slower than that in September; the wind power generated by industrial enterprises above the designated size increased by 34.0 percent, with a growth rate of 2.4 percentage points faster than that in September; the solar power generated by industrial enterprises above the designated size increased by 12.6 percent, with a growth rate of 0.1 percentage point slower than that in September.

Crescita delle vendite delle auto elettriche in Cina (New energy vehicles, NEV che includono le auto elettriche e quelle plug-in)




I. Households' Income

In 2024, the nationwide per capita disposable income was 41,314 yuan, a nominal increase of 5.3 percent over the previous year, and the real increase of 5.1 percent after deducting price factor. In terms of urban and rural areas, the per capita disposable income of urban residents was 54,188 yuan, an increase of 4.6 percent (unless otherwise specified, all growth rates mentioned are nominal), and a real increase of 4.4 percent after deducting price factors; the per capita disposable income of rural residents was 23,119 yuan, an increase of 6.6 percent, and a real increase of 6.3 percent after deducting price factors.

According to the source of income, in 2024, the per capita income from wages and salaries of residents nationwide was 23,327 yuan, an increase of 5.8 percent, accounting for 56.5 percent of the per capita disposable income; the per capita net business income was 6,908 yuan, an increase of 5.6 percent, accounting for 16.7 percent of the per capita disposable income; the per capita net income from properties was 3,435 yuan, an increase of 2.2 percent, accounting for 8.3 percent of per capita disposable income; the per capita net income from transfer was 7,644 yuan, an increase of 5.3 percent, accounting for 18.5 percent of the per capita disposable income.

In 2024, the median of the nationwide per capita disposable income was 34,707 yuan, an increase of 5.1 percent, and the median was 84.0 percent of the average. Among them, the median of the per capita disposable income of urban residents was 49,302 yuan, an increase of 4.6 percent, and the median was 91.0 percent of the average; the median of the per capita disposable income of rural residents was 19,605 yuan, an increase of 4.6 percent, and the median was 84.8 percent of the average.

Per Capita Disposable Income of Urban and Rural Residents Nationwide for 2024




II. Consumption Expenditure of Households

In 2024, the nationwide per capita consumption expenditure was 28,227 yuan, a nominal increase of 5.3 percent over the previous year, and the real increase of 5.1 percent after deducting price factors. In terms of urban and rural areas, the per capita consumption expenditure of urban residents was 34,557 yuan, an increase of 4.7 percent, and a real increase of 4.5 percent after deducting price factors; the per capita consumption expenditure of rural residents was 19,280 yuan, an increase of 6.1 percent, and a real increase of 5.8 percent after deducting price factors.

In 2024, the nationwide per capita consumption expenditure on food, tobacco and liquor was 8,411 yuan, an increase of 5.4 percent, accounting for 29.8 percent of the per capita consumption expenditure; the per capita consumption expenditure on clothing was 1,521 yuan, an increase of 2.8 percent, accounting for 5.4 percent of the per capita consumption expenditure; the per capita consumption expenditure; the per capita consumption expenditure; the per capita consumption expenditure on household facilities, articles and services was 1,547 yuan, an increase of 1.4 percent, accounting for 5.5 percent of the per capita consumption expenditure; the per capita consumption expenditure on transportation and telecommunication was 3,976 yuan, an increase of 8.9 percent, accounting for 14.1 percent of per capita consumption expenditure; the per capita consumption expenditure on education, culture and recreation was 3,189 yuan, an increase of 9.8 percent, accounting for 11.3 percent of the per capita consumption expenditure; the per capita consumption expenditure on miscellaneous goods and services was 773 yuan, an increase of 10.8 percent, accounting for 2.7 percent of the per capita consumption expenditure.
